The Next Chapter Capital Campaign is a strategic campus expansion of the Westminster Academy Blanche Collins Forman Campus, founded by the late Dr. D. James Kennedy in 1971.

Everyone loves a good story. Westminster Academy's story began in a living room with a handful of committed volunteers praying, thinking, and dreaming about a school. Our founders were motivated to create a place that combined **academic rigor** with **spiritual vitality**—because they understood that faith and learning are inextricably linked. They envisioned a school that would make a difference in our city, our state, our nation, and our world. Today, we are witnesses to that vision being fulfilled every day.

More than 50 years later, over 4,000 alumni are now part of that story. More than 1,000 students are currently immersed in a caring, Christ-centered community where lessons are learned, friendships grow, and biblical worldviews are formed. We are a culture committed to excellence in all things—and all things to God's glory—a community where **each student is known and loved**.

It has been some time since our school community has fully capitalized on the vision so evident in our legacy—one worthy of another bold chapter. We are now poised for that Next Chapter because of the preparation of the past nine years. As of Fall 2025, Westminster Academy has reinvested \$10 million into our campus, retired \$1.5 million in obligations, built \$3 million in reserves, and launched an aggressive faculty compensation initiative.

Our financial audits confirm that we are in a strong position to launch a capital campaign.

Additionally, Westminster Academy became the third Florida member of the Council for Educational Standards and Accountability (CESA)—one of the nation's most respected organizations for Christian schools, known for its rigorous academic and financial standards. The time is at hand.

The Next Chapter of our story builds on our founders' vision. Our strategic campus expansion master plan reflects excellence, embraces our mission, and creates new opportunities for students, families, faculty, and alumni to **build community** within a **safe, self-contained campus**. It is an ambitious vision—worthy of both our legacy and our support.




Campus Expansion Master Plan

Community Lawn and Parking

The acquisition of our North Campus expands both our footprint and our opportunities. In its first phase, the property will become a Community Lawn—a versatile space for athletic practices, recess, and events, alongside additional parking. Site planning and city approval will proceed concurrently with the fundraising and construction of Phase One. Demolition and lawn development have been funded by a \$1 million investment from the School Board’s reserves—a clear demonstration of their strong support and excitement for this transformational addition to our campus.

Proposed Concepts

Fieldhouse and Early Childhood Center

The vision for the new 4-acre North Campus includes an Early Childhood Center, allowing more young families to begin their journey at Westminster Academy and giving children the opportunity to grow up in a Christ-centered environment from preschool through graduation.

A new Fieldhouse will provide additional athletic facilities and a versatile multi-purpose space for robotics, student activities, and community events—expanding opportunities for students, enriching campus life, and strengthening our sense of community across all ages.

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| 1971 | <p>A Legacy Begins</p> <p>With 340 students and 21 teachers meeting in four temporary locations—including the Pompano Race Track and a hotel—Westminster Academy opened its doors, stepping forward in faith to begin a lasting legacy of Christian education.</p> |  |
| 1978-1979 | <p>Expanding Academics and Athletics</p> <p>The addition of the Arts and Science Wing and completion of the James F. Lindsay Gymnasium expanded opportunities for students in both academics and athletics.</p> |  |
| 1994 | <p>Investing in the Arts and Technology</p> <p>The Media and Fine Arts Building opened, housing two libraries, computer labs, orchestra, band, and administrative offices. This milestone was made possible through the generosity of the Hamilton M. and Blanche C. Forman Christian Foundation, and the campus was named the Blanche Collins Forman Campus in their honor.</p> |  |
| 1997-1999 | <p>Building for Growth</p> <p>The purchase of the West Campus added 34 acres for a premier athletic complex, while the swimming complex on the East Campus further enriched Westminster Academy’s athletic and physical education programs.</p> |  |
| 2018-2019 | <p>Innovation for the Future</p> <p>Major renovations included the Dr. Kenneth P. Wackes Media Center, named for our Headmaster Emeritus, and the IQ Lab, a STEAM-focused innovation space designed to inspire creativity, collaboration, and discovery.</p> |  |
| 2016-Present | <p>Stewarding God’s Resources Well</p> <p>Over the past nine years, Westminster Academy has invested \$10 million in campus improvements—faithfully maintaining facilities while preparing for future expansion.
